**Registration for the 2020/2021 school year begins on
Friday, January 24th, at 9 AM.**

Registration is on a first come, first serve basis.

- ❖ The registration/insurance fee for the 2020/2021 school year will be \$75.00 for currently enrolled students, siblings and alumni. The registration/insurance fee for new students is \$100.00.
- ❖ You will be required to fill out the attached form, choose your child's schedule and attach a check for the non-refundable registration/insurance fee. This fee will allow us to process your application. Attached are the application form and tuition fees.
- ❖ **Please be sure to tell your friends that Registration will open to the public on Monday, January 27th at 9 am.** We truly appreciate the referrals that you make to our pre-school. The best advertisement is a happy family!

In order to provide the best age appropriate education, children will be admitted to classes according to the following cut-off dates:

- 1's class - Must be 1 to start the program
- 2's class - Must be 2 to start program
- 3's class - Must be 3 by October 31
- 4's class - Must be 4 by October 31
- TK class - Must be 5 by December 31

The director and faculty reserve the right to evaluate and recommend placements that deviate from the above policy.
