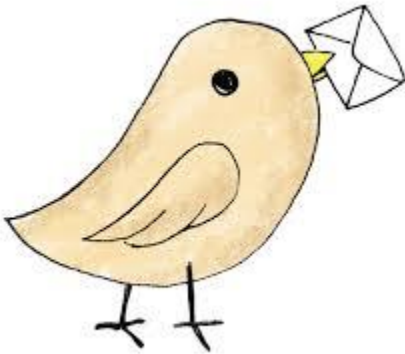
Thanks to Dave Ludwig who will lead in-person, in-door service on Sunday. It will also be available on Zoom and Facebook Live.
